SUBJECT: Two Person Safety Belts

TO: All Distributors, Dealers, Owners and Operators

It has been brought to our attention that our Company has been slightly "out of bounds" in regard to furnishing information concerning the use of safety belts which do not have the TSO approval.

All information which has been submitted by our Company concerning the use of these belts is hereby withdrawn and is regarded as inaccurate and should no longer be used.

Henceforth on Piper Models PA-12, PA-14, PA-15, PA-16, PA-17, and early PA-20's and PA-22's all replacement belts sold must be a Two Person TSO Belt. Approved belts for these Models just mentioned are available through the Piper Dealer or Distributor in your area. The number of this belt is 751 391 and the price is \$12.75##. This is a complete belt assembly, including both buckle and tip end.

Inasmuch as the Models J-5A and J-5B are considered obsolete by the Piper Aircraft Corporation, belts for these subject airplanes can be obtained from the Associated Suppliers Company, Division of B - N Corporation, 3355 Glendale Boulevard, Los Angeles 39, California. The number of this belt is BN2-999-C-30-38.
